On Snowshoe tours, dress in layers with powder pants and snow boots. Hats and gloves are needed too.

On all tours, bring a water bottle, snacks if desired and a camera to record the magnificence.

No experience is necessary to participate on any professionally guided Wanderlust Tour.

Ask about the chance to add outdoor appetizers and drinks or a meal under the trees.

Our tours are conducted in Central Oregon's beautiful outdoors—RAIN or SHINE. Guests must dress appropriately for the weather. Dressing in layers for any trip is advised. Carry a daypack to put extra clothing in.

CANOE & KAYAK TOURS

Cascade Lakes Canoe Tours—half day

Journey into the mighty Cascade Range to paddle the glassy waters of a spectacular mountain lake. As the only guided tours available on the Cascades Lakes, Wanderlust Tours' renowned guides will highlight tucked-away spots on these beautiful lakes that you may never find by going there on your own – be sure to watch for otter, mink, osprey and eagles, and bring a camera for the best mountain views in Central Oregon. We spend 2 ¼ hours on the water for relaxation, team-building and soaking in the beauty!

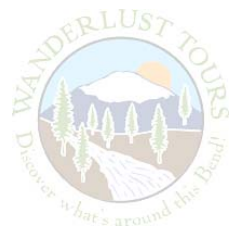
Cascade Lakes Kayak Tours - half day

- Most appropriate for adults

- Maximum kayak weigh limit 400 lbs total (2 people per kayak)

Moonlight Canoe Tours—evening

Experience canoeing by the light of the moon on nights surrounding each full moon. The moon's bright light reflects off of the shimmering water! Dessert and hot drinks served on the lakeshore top off this spectacular evening.

Brews and Views Canoe Tours—half day

Wanderlust Tours' famous Cascade Lakes Canoe Tours with the added fun of a beer tasting event! Paddle the water of a pristine mountain lake with a naturalist guide and taste various beers from one of Bend's local brewing companies and hear the story of their crafting.

Flat water Deschutes River Canoe and Kayak Tours—half day, March through May

The Deschutes and Spring rivers are two silvery ribbons that carve Sunriver's western boundary. These rivers, the earth's life-blood, provide a dramatic means to take in the best of this area. Bald eagles, native rainbow trout, and mink cavort as we roll down the river. The headwaters of Spring River prove to be just that--ancient well springs--having descended from high in the Cascades. This is relaxation at its best!

Note: Even if groups have canoed the Deschutes on their own before, this is a completely different part of the river—plus Spring River—providing a truly fabulous experience with a Wanderlust guide!

CAVE, VOLCANO AND GPS ECO-CHALLENGE TOURS

Cave Tours—half day, year round

Discover the hidden underground world of Central Oregon's remote lava caves with a naturalist guide! These large cool caverns are safe and fascinating! Leading groups with headlamps for all, our guides will provide in-depth interpretation on the formation of the lava tubes, the wildlife habitat inside the caves and the many uses of the caves over time from native American dwellings to cold storage for early Bend residents. Central Oregon's caves are delicate ecosystems that few have experienced in this way! Wanderlust Tours is the only guide company permitted in these caves.

(Note: This is not Lava River Cave on Hwy 97 – we take you away from the crowds!)

At 6,300 feet you'll walk on a mountain of black glass, hike the shores of sparkling Paulina Lake through an old growth hemlock forest and experience Paulina Creek's plunging waterfalls! This trip is a combination of various short, easy walks on relatively flat ground totaling about 2 miles.

Crater Lake- The Gem of Oregon - Hiking or Snowshoeing

Oregon's only **National Park**, our visit begins at the Pumice Desert, a remnant of Mt. Mazama's tremendous blast. We'll next ascend the north flank of the volcano and arrive on the rim for incredible views down to Crater Lake. Several stops on the rim will give everyone great vantage points while the guide unfurls the geologic history. Wanderlust Tours will provide a wonderful picnic lunch under old-growth trees on the lake's rim. We will travel the rest of the rim before heading back to the Bend area.

Lava Lands plus Benham Falls

Explore Lava Lands where we will begin our journey to the top of a volcano which sits within a 10-square-mile lava field, our guide will share the fabulous central Oregon geology with the group. We'll walk around the crater at the top before heading off to Benham Falls. After a short drive arrive at Benham Falls for a 1-mile round trip walk through the forest. The placid Deschutes River turns torrid as it falls over the lava, yet the serenity of aspen groves along this gentle hike has a calming effect.

Add a visit to The High Desert Museum

Visit the nationally acclaimed High Desert Museum where our guide will give a 30-minute tour of the Spirit of the West, a walk-through-time exhibit of High Desert history. This tour will set the stage for the rest of their visit. Guests will then have time to explore the museum on their own.

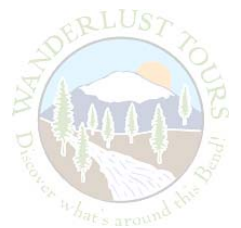
Tumalo Falls Hike

This stunning hike will begin at the base of 85-foot Tumalo Falls and will take us up along the North Fork of Tumalo Creek where one waterfall after the next drops into deep pools carved into the forest floor. Basalt, wildflowers and chilly water fill our senses while silence of the forest reigns. Rated moderate – 4 miles.

- Tours depart 8:30 a.m. –1 p.m. or 1– 5:30 p.m.
- Cost: \$49 per person
- Best time June- October
- Includes naturalist guide and transportation
- Maximum elevation- 5,500 feet
- Tour Length- 4.5 hours
- Bend Departures necessary for small groups of 4 or fewer

Tumalo Mountain Trek

Get ready to head into the heart of the Cascade Mountain Range, the backbone of Oregon! Our ascent will take us up 1,500 feet to Tumalo Mountain's spectacular 7,800-foot summit. This volcano sits right next to Mt. Bachelor, Broken Top and South Sister, a great spot for our guide to highlight the region's geology from what is perhaps the most impressive view of the Central Oregon Cascades. Rated challenging – 3.5 miles. We recommend this hike in the morning if July or August.



- Tours depart at 8:30 a.m.-1 p.m. or 1 p.m.-5:30 p.m.

- Maximum elevation- 7,800 feet

Sisters plus the Metolius River

This leisurely excursion takes us into outstanding old growth forests comprising the cinnamon-colored Ponderosa Pine. A short walk will lead us to the Head of the Metolius River where we'll witness pure waters springing from the earth. Then it's on to Sisters, a quaint western town, for some shopping and lunch. Suggestions for lunch in Sisters will be given to the group or lunch can be provided and we will make the appropriate stop. Another option is a group lunch at a local restaurant.
